Subject: Call for volunteers to join the EHC Youth Committee

Dear NMOs,

The European Haemophilia Consortium (EHC) is currently looking for up to five (5) volunteers to join the EHC Youth Committee for a period of three years (2027-2029).

The aim of the committee is to represent young people living with bleeding disorders at the European level, promote the development of youth leadership in organisational, scientific, therapeutic, social, and institutional domains within the bleeding disorder community, develop the programme to organise and implement the Youth Leadership Workshop, and to support EHC's international representation by contributing youth perspectives when appropriate.

The EHC is currently inviting applications for:

- Up to **five (5) volunteers** for the position of **EHC Youth Ambassador**:
 - **three (3)** newly appointed members
 - **two (2)** members reappointed from previous mandates

The ideal candidate will:

- Be between 18 and 30 years of age at the time of nomination,
- Be a member and nominated by one of the EHC National Member Organisations (NMO),
- Be a patient or carrier of one of the bleeding disorders covered by the mandate of the EHC, or be the sibling or child of a person with a bleeding disorder covered by the mandate of the EHC; alternatively, a candidate may be a member of an NMO without a personal or family history of a bleeding disorder, provided they have demonstrated a strong and sustained personal commitment to their NMO and the bleeding disorder community,
- Be fluent in English,
- Have been an active NMO volunteer for at least three years,

- Be committed to dedicating enough time to fulfilling the activities carried out by the Youth Committee.

To apply for this position, candidates will need to send:

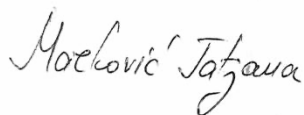
- The candidate's CV, outlining in particular relevant experience such as volunteering,
- A motivation letter outlining their background briefly and why they are interested in joining the Youth Committee,
- A letter of recommendation from the NMO outlining why they believe the candidate would make a great addition to the Youth Committee,
